>> An introduction to peDOCS

peDOCS is an open access repository which unites electronic full texts from educational research, and makes them available free of charge. The service is globally available, owing to its integration into the German Education Portal – the central access point to education research and findability in international search engines. Moreover, peDOCS co-operates with the German National Library (DNB) and thus asserts long-term archiving of provided texts. Researchers can enter their publications on peDOCS themselves to make them openly accessible. peDOCS also works closely with renowned publishers.

>> Full text services offered by peDOCS

peDOCS offers a broad scope of text types: initial open access publications, secondary releases of published titles, re-publishing of titles that are out of print, qualification theses like doctoral theses, habilitation theses, and many more.

>> Visibility of publication(s)

peDOCS uses different means of distribution to assure that publications are visible and findable.

Publications are, for example, accessible via:

- · German Education Portal
- Google and other search engines
- BASE, OpenAIRE or OAlster (to OAl interface)
- German Education Index
- · Online catalogue of the German National Library (OPAC)

>> Other services and benefits

- Information concerning the review status of a publication (e.g. peer reviewed)
- Citation certainty by assignment of a persistent internet address (URN)
- Long-term archiving by the German National Library (DNB)
- · Quality assurance via DINI certification
